COACHING STAFF

BERNIE DRISCOLL Head Coach

Bernie Driscoll returns for his eleventh season as head coach of men's basketball team at Kutztown University.

Last season, Driscoll guided Kutz-

town to its second Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference East title with a 10-2 record, tying the school record for conference wins in a season. The last team to win 10 wins was the 1988-89 team, also the last team to claim the PSAC East title.

In his eight years at the helm of the Golden Bears, Driscoll has tallied a 114-105 overall record. Following a two-year rebuilding process, he has posted a 103-65 mark the last six seasons. Driscoll has led the Golden Bears to six straight winning seasons and a program record six-straight PSAC playoff appearances. His mark in PSAC East play stands at 48-48, but KU is 44-28 over the last six years.

In 2005-06, Kutztown finished with a 16-12 overall record, including a 7-5 mark in the PSAC East. The team advanced to the conference quarterfinals. In 2004-05, the team was 15-12 overall, also advancing to the quarterfinals. KU was ranked as high as 17th in the nation. The 2003-04 season was one of the best in the program's history. The Golden Bears finished 18-11 overall, including 7-5 in the PSAC East. KU reached the PSAC title game for the first time in 16 years. In 2002-03, Driscoll's club had a remarkable turnaround and he earned PSAC East Coach of the Year honors. After winning a combined 11 games in two years, the Golden Bears went 18-10 overall, and 8-4 in the PSAC East. The squad made its first PSAC playoff appearance since 1999, winning the second-most games in school history.

Driscoll, 52, received a bachelor's degree in biology from Dickinson College, Carlisle, Pa., in 1977. He received a master's degree in education from St. Joseph's University, Philadelphia, in 1988.

Driscoll and his wife, Liz, have three children — daughters, Maureen (25) and Kelly (22), and son, Ricky (21).

COACHING STAFF

TOM YORK Assistant Coach

Tom York enters his tenth season as assistant men's basketball coach at Kutztown University.

A KU graduate with a bachelor's degree in elementary education, York was a three-year starter and two-time MVP selection as a Golden Bear. He earned All-PSAC East honors in 1981-82. After coaching at Phoenixville and Glen Mills high schools, York compiled a 96-92 record in seven seasons as KU's head women's basketball coach (1987-94). He was named PSAC East Coach of the Year after guiding the women's basketball team to an 18-10 record in 1989-90.

York then spent four stellar seasons as head coach of girls' basketball at Wilson High School (1996-00) in West Lawn, PA. He compiled a record of 105-20, winning two county championships and three AAAA District III titles. He came back to KU from Exeter High School, where he coached girls' basketball in 2000-01.

York and his wife, Wendy, have two children - son, Travis (19) and daughter, Amanda (17).

CAMP INFORMATION

CAMP PHILOSOPHY...

Our camp will provide the opportunity for campers to participate in basketball related activities in the summer. Play can be improved through daily practice and games.

SITES AND FACILITIES...

The camp is held on the campus of Kutztown University. Keystone Hall Arena will be the camp headquarters with Keystone Hall Field House providing additional court space.

OFFICIALS...

Officiating is done by certified I.A.A.B.O. officials.

INSURANCE & MEDICAL CARE...

There will be a professional medical trainer on duty at all times. The student health clinic is available as well as a doctor on call. Campers will be required to fill out a medical form prior to camp.

ACCOMODATIONS...

Each camper will be housed two to a room in a residence hall. Please make sure you specify your roommate preference on the application. All room assignments will be made prior to registration. The Counselors/Coaches will reside in the dorm with the campers, providing the campers with constant supervision. Each camper will be required to provide his own bedding (*sheets, pillows and pillow cases, towels and shower items*).

MEALS...

Meals will be served at South Dining Hall located adjacent to the dormitory. The professional dining hall staff plans and prepares all meals. Three cafeteria-style meals will be served daily on an "all-you-can-eat" basis.

PHONE CALLS...

If you need to contact a camper, a message can be left at the Basketball office 24 hours a day by calling (610) 683-4064. Messages will be retrieved on a regular basis. In case of an emergency, call (610) 683-1376.

COST...

Cost of the camp is \$200 per overnight camper, and \$125 per day for commuter.
