2008 PSAC EAST COACH OF
THE YEAR



Betty Wesner enters her 31st season as head field hockey coach at Kutztown University.

Wesner has played a vital role in the growth of field hockey and women's athletics at Kutztown over the past 30 years. She has posted a winning percentage of .565 in those 30 seasons.

In the past five seasons, Wesner's teams have combined for 81 wins and 5 trips to the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) playoffs. In 2007 the Golden Bears were ranked as high as first in Division II and first in the South Region. Wesner was also voted 2007 & 2008 PSAC Coach of the Year and 2007 South Region Coach of the year. In the 2008 season Wesner recorded her 300th career victory in overtime decision against Mercyhurst College.

In 1997, the Golden Bears reached the pinnacle of success, advancing to the NCAA Division II Championship game for the first time in school history. For her effort, Wesner was named National Field Hockey Coaches' Association (NFHCA) Division II Coach of the Year, as well as NFCHA South Region, PSAC and Kutztown University Women's Coach of the Year. Academically, Wesner's teams have consistently been ranked in the top 5 for Division II schools.

Camp Rules

There will be no tolerance for smoking, possession or consumption of illegal drugs and alcoholic beverages. Misconduct will result in the camper forfeiting her registration fee and being dismissed from the camp immediately. Keys to camper vehicles will remain in the possession of the camp director until the end of the camp. We expect the campers to respect the University's facilities while attending our camp. The individual camp is designed to improve an individual's skill level and team play. The team camp will provide a format concentrating on team cohesiveness and intense playing. Excellent competition will be our main goal.

General Camp Information



The Elite Camp is located at Kutztown University in small, quaint Kutztown, PA. There are extensive hockey fields, indoor facilities in case of inclement weather, and an indoor swimming pool staffed by certified lifeguards. Campers are housed in University residence halls staffed by camp counselors and coaches. The dining hall will provide three nutritious all-you-can-eat meals, including a complete salad bar, each day. Each camper is reminded to provide her own stick, bed linens, swimming suit and other personal items needed for dormitory living. Mouth and shin guards are mandatory.

Directions

The campus is 20 minutes from the Northeast Extension of the Pennsylvania Turnpike (Exit 56- Lehigh Valley) and five minutes from Interstate 78 West to Exit 40 (Kutztown/Krumsville) to Rt. 737 South to Kutztown. Turn right on Main St. and proceed up the hill to campus. Kutztown is located about 2 hours from NYC, 3 hours from the Baltimore/Washington area, 1 1/2 hours from Philadelphia, just over an hour from Harrisburg and only a half hour from Reading and Allentown.

GOALIE CAMP

This camp will feature specialized individual instruction to all goalies. Goalies will work independently with special attention to conditioning, footwork and instruction focused on goalies' needs. In the evening, they will play with their teams in games.
